

Dr. Padaruth Ramlachan



Dr. Ramlachan received his medical degree from the University of Natal in 1985. He is the president of the African Society for Sexual Medicine (ASSM). He completed his internship at the King Edward VII Hospital before embarking on a career in general practice with an interest in sexual health. He is the Chairman of the Durban Doctor's Guild since 2000 and also serves as the Chairman of the Pharmaceutical and therapeutics Committee of the KZN DHC. He has served on numerous Boards and is the past Chairperson of SASHA KZN and is at present the President of the African Society for Sexual Medicine

(ASSM). He is a part-time lecturer in the department of Family Medicine at the Nelson Mandela School of Medicine and structures the Sexual health modules for both the undergraduate and postgraduate students in Family Medicine. In 2007 he received a Master's Degree in Health Sciences (Sexual Health) from the University of Sydney. He serves as a member of the Finance Committee of the ASSM. He received the Fellow of the European Committee of Sexual Medicine (FECSM) from the European Union of Medical Specialist in 2012. Dr Ramlachan is the founder of the Jyoti Jivanam Movement of South Africa, a movement that distributed 7000 food hampers in 2014. He is the Director of the Newkwa Sexual Health and Wellness Centre.
